- 1 packet of 12 thick crayons (ideally Jovi)
- 1 pencil case with zipper (labelled)
- 1 glue stick
- 1 small bottle white craft glue
- 1 bingo marker
- 1 palette and thick paintbrush (labelled)
- 1 whiteboard + 2 whiteboard markers (labelled)
- 4 packets of wipes
- 4 boxes of tissues
- 1 packet of paper plates
- 1 apron with sleeves (labelled)
- 1 cushion (labelled)
- 1 sheet stickers
- 4 A4 kartoncin
- 4 big white kartoncin
- 2 big any colour kartoncin
- 4 jars playdough (Jovi or Play do brand) (labelled)
- 1 reusable cup (labelled)
- 1 big ball (labelled)
- 2 passport photos
- 30 euros for additional material

On the first day of school, your child should bring a small school backpack containing two packed lunches and a child-friendly water bottle.

For children travelling by bus, please ensure they wear a name tag clearly displaying their name and your contact number.
